



Resolution of the Vice-Chancellor for Research and Scientific Policy, which makes public the definitive award of grants for two predoctoral contracts within the Horizon Europe Marie Sklodowska-Curie Doctoral Networks Programme Project number 101119258 Archaeological Coastal Heritage: Past, present and future of a hidden prehistoric legacy (ARCHE), funded by the European Commission.

By Resolution of the Vice-Chancellor for Research and Scientific Policy, the call for grants within the Marie Sklodowska-Curie Horizon Europe Programme Doctoral Networks within the framework of Law 14/2011, of 1 June, on Science, Technology and Innovation amended by Law 17/2022, of 5 September, on Science, Technology and Innovation, was made public.

By Resolution dated May 3, 2024 of the Vice-Rector for Research and Scientific Policy, the provisional list of grants granted and reserve grants is published.

In accordance with the provisions of the call for proposals, the Selection Committee of the project ARCHE agrees:

First.- To make the provisional proposal for the concession definitive, so that those listed in Annex I for each grant will be considered selected candidates.

Second.- The incorporation and registration of the new hires will take place on Monday, September 2, 2024, in accordance with the provisions of section I.5 of the call, of January 29, 2024, upon presentation by the interested parties of the documents included in point I.5.6 of the call

Third.- In the event that vacancies occur due to non-incorporation or resignations within the 4 months following the date of incorporation of the new hires, new grants will be awarded in the order established by the Selection Committee in the list of reserve grants included in Annex II.

Fourth.- The beneficiaries of these grants are obliged to comply with the rules contained in the call, as well as those established by the General Law on Subsidies for recipients of public aid and subsidies.

Against this decision, the appeals established by the Law on the Legal Regime of Public Administrations and the Common Administrative Procedure may be filed.
